The Roundtables

The GRI Roundtables gather locally-based, experienced practitioners to explore challenges and best practices in sustainability reporting in an intimate environment. The Roundtables, held four times annually, "go deep" in two specific practice areas per day to help organizations consider how the GRI Sustainability Reporting Standards can be implemented more effectively within both the GRI principles of reporting and the company's own material topics. Facilitated by a member of GRI staff, the Roundtables are designed to maximize co-learning and networking among participants.
